ABOUT THE PROGRAMME

Partnering with IMPAC, to deliver the Early in Careers Programme (EiC) which is designed for new Wellbeing, Healthy and Safety (WHS) practitioners, coordinators and H&S Reps who have recently started their careers in WHS.

PROGRAMME DETAILS

Our programme consists of four workshop modules, delivered on a six weekly basis in Wellington. The EiC programme has been tailored to build core WHS knowledge in four key areas. Upon completion of the programme attendees will have achieved a Early in Careers Certificate (Level 3 qualification).

Each workshop covers a stand-alone topic, with all modules cumulatively providing a solid foundation of learning for all attendees.

These three-hour workshops will be facilitated by IMPAC, using a structured learning approach including a range of interactive activities, discussions and practical exercises that can be used back in the workplace. Each attendee will need to complete a short online e-learning module after each workshop.
