•Health & Safety Risk Fundamentals
– Learners will gain an understanding of core H&S concepts including hazard/harm/risk/risk factors/risk controls.

•Worker Engagement, Participation and Representation – Learners will gain a greater understanding on how to engage key stakeholders and facilitate meaningful participation and representation in an H&S context.

•Working with other PCBU's
– Learners will gain an understanding on the legal principles that underpin the overlapping duties to consult, cooperate and coordinate

•Reporting and Measuring Performance – Learners will gain a greater understanding of performance indicators and their relationship to workplace risk

PROGRAMME COMPONENTS:

This programme consists of four workshop modules which are tailored to recognise EIC H&S practitioners specific learning needs. Each workshop covers a stand-alone topic, with all modules cumulatively providing a solid foundation of learning for all attendees. These three-hour workshops will be facilitated by IMPAC and include a range of interactive activities, discussions, and practical exercises. Each workshop module will provide a general understanding of the topic, its importance, the risks/impacts associated for the organisation or workforce. At the end of the workshop, the EIC practitioner will be able to apply their learning in a useful way back in the office, or onsite, supported by resources supplied at the workshops.
