


88% of the 25 agencies who responded reported conducting assurance of their wellbeing, health and safety systems within the last two years

Fatal injuries- three year moving average - per 100,000 FTE




From 2012 to 2022 there have been seven recorded fatal injuries across the GHSL member agencies relating to Assault, Vehicles, Drowning and Fall from height


All harm reported to ACC - per 1000 FTE's




Recorded mechanisms of Injuries resulting in a week or

Injuries resulting in a week or more away from work






Serious harm rate resulting in week or more away from work by statistic's defined industry categories - rate per 1000 FTE's

questionnaire and reported areas of risk on their work programme.




